
Who are we?



Altogether Autism provides a national information and advisory service for autistic people, their families, whānau, professionals and the wider community. Your Way I Kia Roha and Parent to Parent New Zealand provide this Ministry of Health-funded service in partnership.

Services we provide include:

- Individualised information on autism and issues affecting Autistic people
- Altogether Autism Journal
- Contact with a support parent whose son or daughter also has autism

- Sibling support for sisters and brothers of someone on the autism spectrum
- Evidence-based information and clinical advice from autism researchers and clinicians
- Lived experience insights from Autistic people

- Community network meetings and seminars
- Professional Development workshops.



Trusted Information

Altogether Autism provides evidence-based autism information tailored to your individual request, including issues affecting Autistic people, as well as information on diagnosis, rights and access to education, Needs Assessment Service Coordination (NASC) and support.

Expert advice

If you contact us wanting lived experience information and advice, we refer your request to our Consumer Reference Group, made up of Autistic people and family/whānu of people on the autism spectrum. We provide you with clinical and evidence-based information and advice through our specialist researchers, our consultant clinical psychologist and a national Professional Expert Group.

Network meetings

You are also welcome to come to our free community network meetings, held throughout Aotearoa New Zealand, where Autistic people, their families/whānau, providers and professionals can get together to share stories, strategies and support.

Sibling Support

Specialised sibling support is provided by Parent to Parent and includes Sibdays and Sibcamps for siblings aged 8 -18 years and Second-Generation weekends for adults.

Autism workshops


Our Professional Development Series presents information developed in consultation with Autistic people and clinicians and delivered by experienced facilitators who have an in-depth knowledge of autism.

Altogether Autism, he mea whakarite hei mātanga whakaputa kōrero ki te motu, hei ringa hautū mō te tangata me ngā kaupapa whai takiwātanga, ma ngā whānau, kaimahi me ngā hāpori whānui hoki. Ko ngā uepū Your Way I Kia Roha me Parent to Parent New Zealand e mahi tahi ana, hei ringa āwhina mo tēnei Manatū hauora.

He korero pumau enei:

Ko te mahi o te roopu Altogether Autism he whakawhāiti i ngā korero rangahau, katahi ka whakahāngaihia ki ngā patapatai a te tangata, otirā, ki te hunga whai takiwātanga, tae atu hoki ki te āhua o te whakatau i tērā tūmomo tangata. He whakamārama i ngā tikanga me ngā mātauranga ka whakawhiwhia ki a rātou, hei tāpiri hoki ko te Needs Assessments Services Coordination (NASC) me ngā tautoko kei te taha.

Te mātanga o ngā kōrero:

Ki te whakapā mai tētahi, e hiahia ana ki te tūtaki ki tētahi kua pakeke mai i roto i tēnei tūmomo whakatipu. ka tukuna tērā hiahia ki tō mātou tira Consumer Reference Group, ko tōna āhua mo te tangata, mo te whānau rānei kei runga i te pae o te momo takiwātanga e noho ana. Ka tāea hoki e mātou te tuku i ngā puna kōrero kua whakawāhia e ngā tohunga, me ona maramtanga mai i to mātou roopu kairangahau, ki ō mātou tohunga kaimātai i te hauora o te hinengaro, tae atu hoki ki tētahi roopu whai take mo te motu ko te Professional Expert Group te ingoa.

Te tautoko i te tuakana me te teina
